



At Belmont University we strive to provide quality health services to our students. The **Belmont University Health Form** must be completed by you and your health care provider.

The form is divided into 4 main sections:

- Demographic information
- Health insurance information (please attach a copy of the front and back of your card)
- Physical examination
- Immunization record Your health care provider must complete the physical examination section and your immunization record. Please make sure that your provider signs off at the bottom of the Health Form.

The state of Tennessee requires proof of two (2) Measles, Mumps, and Rubella vaccinations for all students born on or after January, 1, 1957. If you are unable to obtain your childhood immunization records, Belmont University will accept proof of one (1) MMR vaccination received in 1999 or thereafter.

The Hepatitis B (HBV) vaccine is also required for all students attending universities or colleges in the state of Tennessee. For optimal protection a series of three (3) doses of vaccine is required. To comply, proof of at least one initial dose of Hepatitis B vaccine must be submitted. Missed doses may still be sought to complete the series if only one or two have been obtained. Due to the seriousness of the disease we strongly urge receipt of this vaccine. However, if you choose not to have the vaccine, the waiver found on the reverse side of the Health Form must be signed.

The Meningococcal Meningitis vaccine is required for all new students residing on campus. Due to the seriousness of the disease and increased risk from close living quarters, we strongly urge receipt of this vaccine. However, if you choose not to have the vaccine, the waiver found on the reverse side of the Health Form must be signed.

Belmont University requires a Tuberculin skin test within the last 12 months and a Tetanus injection within the past ten years. Students in the College of Health Sciences have additional immunization requirements that are explained on the Health Form.
