

## **Nursing school at Belmont gets grant**

The Memorial Foundation approved a \$500,000 grant to Belmont University's Gordon E. Inman College of Health Sciences and Nursing yesterday.

The first of two buildings, which will house the college's nursing, occupational therapy, physical therapy and social work programs, should be finished in a year. The grant will be used to furnish the complex with equipment, including simulators, task trainers, computer software, videoconferencing and satellite communications Web-casting capabilities.

The facility is funded in part by a \$10.5 million contribution from entrepreneur and banker Gordon Inman and a \$7.5 million investment from HCA and TriStar Health System. ■
