

## Hannon Hill – Glossary of User Terms (last update: 16 June 2006)

- **Dashboard** –The main interface for editing the site. The dashboard is a point of entry that allows the user to create and manage content, check messages from other users and manage workflow on your site(s). The Dashboard also provides the user with a detailed history of actions s/he has recently taken on the site.
- **Cascade Server** – A space where content is created and edited before it is reviewed or published.
- **Staging Server** – A completely functional version of the site that is not public, but holds the latest updates.
- **Destination/Target Server -- The** space where the public views the site.
- **Assets** – An umbrella term that covers images, styles, templates and blocks.
- **Blocks** – Reusable chunks of code that can be used in multiple locations. For example, the commonly used block might be a piece of code that allows users to create an RSS feed from Belmont News.
- **CSS (Cascading Style Sheets)** – Rules that determine layouts, fonts and other stylistic elements of the site.
- **Page** – A placeholder for user-generated content that can be exported to a variety of different formats including PDF, JAWS and hand held devices.
- **Templates** – A standardized structural format for developing pages. A template will include a user-defined design space.
- **Data Defined Template** – A form-driven page where content is added into a structured, standardized format. Data defined templates will be used primarily on faculty and staff profile pages as well as student testimonial pages.
